Background

In June 2010 the Council of European Union adopted the EU Plan of Action on Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment in Development for the period 2010-2015 (EU-GAP). Herewith the EU Ministers for Foreign Affairs reiterated their strong commitment to gender equality as a human right, a question of social justice and a core value of the EU development policy. The Action Plan builds upon previous legal and policy commitments, and consists of an operational framework to accelerate the achievement of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) and other international development goals.

One of the targets set in this Gender Action Plan is that “by 2013 until 2015 the Result Monitoring Reports provide information on the gender sensitiveness of implementation and make recommendations to improve gender performance”.

Purpose of the training:

The purpose of this one-day training is to increase the gender expertise of ROM-monitors. This training provides ROM-monitors:

- Knowledge on basic gender concepts and the rationale for gender mainstreaming;
- Updated information on international and European Policy Commitments and Legal Frameworks on gender and development
- Tools and strategies to identify and address gender issues throughout the monitoring process
- The capacity to formulate recommendations to improve the gender performance of projects/programmes.
